# The Story of the Nutcracker

The Nutcracker, a two-act ballet by Peter Ilyich Tchaikovsky, is perhaps the composer's best-loved work. Tchaikovsky's adaptation of the story "The Nutcracker and the Mouse King" by E.T.A. Hoffmann was commissioned by the director of the Imperial Theatre's Ivan Vsevolozhsky in 1891. The original production was staged by Marius Petipa on December 18, 1892, by The Kirov Ballet in St. Petersburg. In Western countries, The Nutcracker has become perhaps the most popular of all ballets performed during the holiday season.

The curtain opens with Mr. and Mrs. Stahlbaum hosting their annual festive Christmas Eve Party. Alongside them, their children, Clara and Fritz greet their guests as they arrive. Celebration ensues. Clara's favorite uncle, Drosselmeyer, entertains the children with magical tricks, puppets, and dolls. Drosselmeyer brings a special gift for Clara – a magical wooden nutcracker. Delighted, Clara and her friends dance with their dolls. In a jealous fit, Fritz takes the doll and it breaks. Drosselmeyer quickly repairs the nutcracker and returns it to Clara.

The festivities continue as the Stahlbaum's and their guests dance together until the hour grows late and the guests say their goodbyes. The Stahlbaum's retire for the night, but Clara, eager to see her nutcracker doll, goes to check on it and sneaks out of her room. As the clock strikes midnight, Clara drifts off to sleep by the tree and furry mice playfully scurry around her stealing leftovers from the pantry.

The tree grows large and wondrous and the Nutcracker grows too! Toy soldiers dance and the mice return larger with the Rat Queen. A full scale battle ensues and Clara is afraid she will lose her Nutcracker for good. Just when it seems the rats will win, Clara distracts the Queen and the Nutcracker wins the battle! With the Rat Queen gone, an ages old spell on the Nutcracker is broken... He is transformed once again into a handsome Prince. Delighted, the Prince & Clara dance and ride together in an enchanted sleigh to the Land of Snow, where they are greeted by the Snow Queen. Soft snow falls in the beautiful Ice Palace, as snowflakes twirl and dance on the wind.

Clara is then escorted by her Prince to the Kingdom of Sweets where they meet the Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier. The Sugar Plum invites the entire kingdom to entertain them with all the grandeur of the land. They are enticed by decadent chocolate, fine coffee, and aromatic tea. They are further delighted by the dance of the Shepherdess and her lambs, exhilarating Kartoshka folk dancers and a scrumptious Gingersnap treat with Mother Ginger. At last, a garden blooms before them and the Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier dance a grand pas de deux. All of the inhabitants of the Kingdom of Sweets bid farewell to Clara and her Prince and send them on their way to a beautiful future...

...or was it all a dream?

#### **Guest Artists**



Sakura Oka, Sugarplum Fairy - Originally from Nagoya, Japan, Sakura previously danced with both Columbia Classical Ballet and Virginia National Ballet. Now in her third season with Columbia City Ballet, Sakurais a Demi-Soloist, She trained under Maiko Uemura at the Ecole de Ballet MU and had her first opportunity to come to the U.S. in the summer of 2011. In Japan, Sakura successfully auditioned for the Kirov Academy of Ballet Summer Program and was subsequently invited to stay for the year-round program on scholarship. In 2013, Sakura graduated from the Kirov Academy and joined Columbia Classical Ballet. Her beautiful technique has received several awards: 2017 World Ballet Competition Bronze Medalist; 2014 Varna International Competition Semi-Finalist; a Silver Medalist at the 2013 Valentina Kozlova International Ballet Competition; 2013 ADCIBC SR Grand Prix and Second Place in the 2012 Japan Grand Prix.

Sakura has appeared in several principal roles including "Juliet" in Romeo and Juliet, "Sugar Plum Fairy" in Nutcracker, "Kitri" in Don Quixote and "Odile" in Swan Lake.



Leonardo Victorino, Cavalier - Leonardo Victorino, born in Taubaté, SP/Brazil began his pre-professional studies at the Maestro Fego Camargo School of the Arts and then received a full scholarship at the Bolshoi Ballet School. In 2010, he performed with the Companhia Brasileira de Ballet (Rio de Janeiro), where he toured extensively throughout South America. He has performed principal roles in Don Quixote, Giselle, The Magic Flute and The Nutcracker. Mr. Victorino was a member of the Companhia de Ballet do Rio de Janeiro (Brazil) under the direction of Dalal Achcar and danced with Theatro Municipal of Rio de Janeiro in partnership with Companhia de Ballet do Rio de Janeiro. He has performed with the Moscow Ballet for their United States National Tour in 2013 and performed with Albany Berkshire Ballet (NY), and Lake Erie Ballet (PA). Mr. Victorino performed with the Columbia City Ballet under direction of William Starrett and the Washington Ballet under the direction of Septime Webre. He was also a principal dancer with American Contemporary Ballet in Los Angeles and Diablo Ballet in the San Francisco Bay Area. Mr. Victorino is faculty at the Center for Dance Education at Ann Brodie's Carolina Ballet where he directs the classical character program and is a master teacher and Resident Artist with the pre-professional company.




